Abstract:

The font used should be Simplified Arabic, size 12, regular black. Titles should be bold and in size 14, with regular black font for all paragraphs in the paper.

The information in the abstracts must be written in both Arabic and English, ensuring that the meanings are identical. The word count for each abstract should be between 150 and 250 words. Additionally, it is important to ensure that the language used in the abstracts is precise and correct, with attention to proper punctuation within the paragraphs. Weak language in the abstracts may negatively impact the acceptance of the papers for publication within the specified deadlines.

1. Introduction: (Bold Black, Font Size 14)

Should be written in Simplified Arabic, font size 12, with line spacing 1. The introduction should provide a clear background, a clear statement of the problem, relevant literature on the topic, the proposed approach or solution, and the new value of the research. The information should be sequenced from general to specific, citing some studies or statistics that emphasize the importance of the study.

2. Research Problem:

Present the research problem that the study aims to address in depth, emphasizing the contribution of studying this problem to society.

3. Importance of the Study:

Detail the elements that demonstrate the importance of the study, both scientifically and practically.

4. Study Objectives:

Present the objectives of the current study that it aims to achieve.

5. Theoretical Literature of the Study:

Discuss the elements relevant to your study to clarify to the reader the elements they can benefit from in this study, the related dimensions and concepts. You may choose a model or theory that aligns with the nature of the study and apply its hypotheses to your study.

6. Review of Previous Studies:

Refer to a sufficient number of previous studies, which can be divided into themes that suit the nature of the study or listed chronologically, following a clear and uniform pattern in citing previous studies, with analysis of these studies and highlighting the research gap.

7. Methodology:

Clarify the type of study, the methodology used, the study boundaries, the study population and sample, the study tool, the procedures followed, the measures used, and the validity and reliability tests.

8. Results:

Answer the study questions and hypotheses clearly, following correct scientific methodologies. 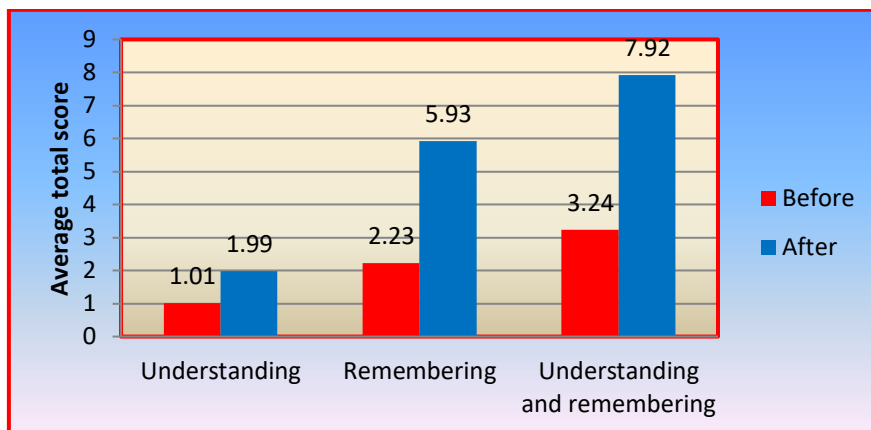


Figure 3:.....

2. Recommendations

The recommendations should be relevant to the study's objectives on both scientific and practical levels, along with offering some research suggestions.

References list

The references list should be alphabetically ordered at the end of the research paper. If the researcher uses sources in both Arabic and English, two separate reference lists must be provided, with Arabic references first, followed by English references.

The journal follows the APA citation style, and the author guide provides instructions for APA formatting. (Arabic: Font type: Simplified Arabic, Font Size 12. English: Font type: Times New Roman, Font Size 12.)

Steps for Publication:

- Receiving the research paper submitted to the journal.
- Initial review of the paper to ensure it meets the journal's publication requirements.
- Informing the researcher of the initial decision within three days of receiving the paper.
- Payment of publication fees if the paper is accepted for peer review and publication.
- Submitted papers are sent to specialized reviewers in the research field, chosen confidentially by the editorial board. The journal may request any revisions to the paper based on the reviewers' feedback before finalizing publication.
- Informing the researcher of the final peer review report.
- Implementing any required revisions or comments based on the reviewers' decision before the final publication of the paper, within a maximum of one week from the date the revisions are sent to the researcher.
- Issuing a certificate of acceptance for publication in the journal.
- Publishing the paper in the upcoming issue of the journal.

Publication Requirements:

1. The research must be original, methodologically sound, and present a modern approach in both topic and presentation.
2. The paper must adhere to correct language usage and style.
3. It must not have been previously published or submitted for publication elsewhere.
4. The academic journal publishes original scientific research with a plagiarism rate not exceeding 20%.
5. The research paper should not exceed 30 pages and should not be less than 15 pages.
6. The research must be complete with all necessary elements.
7. The paper must conform to the journal's formatting guidelines.
8. Accurate and proper scientific citation is required, following the APA citation style.

Research Elements:

One of the most important criteria for the initial acceptance of research for publication in the academic journal is that the research provides a scientific contribution in its field and contributes to community and scientific development. It must include the following essential elements:

1. Research title in both Arabic and English.
2. Author(s) name(s) in both Arabic and English, arranged according to each author's contribution to the research.
3. Author(s) affiliation information (academic degree or professional title, specialization, educational or work institution, city, country, contact details).
4. Research abstract (150-250 words) in both Arabic and English.
5. Keywords (3-5) in both Arabic and English.
6. Introduction.
7. Research sections and contents (should include the previously mentioned elements).
8. Research findings.
9. Discussion of research findings.
10. Recommendations and suggestions.
11. References.

Research Formatting Guidelines:

- **File Type:** The research file must be in Microsoft Word format (.doc or .docx) and should not be locked or password-protected.
- **Research Pages:** The research should be in single pages, not merged into columns on the same page.
- **Headings and Subheadings:** Headings and subheadings should be arranged sequentially.
- **Page Count:** The research should not exceed 30 pages and should not be less than 15 pages.
- **Font Type:** For research written in Arabic: **Simplified Arabic** - Font Size 14 for headings, Font Size 12 for paragraphs (For research written in English: **Times New Roman** - Font Size 14 for headings, Font Size 12 for paragraphs).
- **Page Numbering:** The research should include page numbers, starting with the title page as page one.
- **Language:** The research must be linguistically sound and free from grammatical or spelling errors.
- **References:** The journal uses the "APA" citation style for in-text citations and reference lists. Numbered references in the text are not accepted. For Islamic and legal research, explanatory footnotes and the text and chain of hadith should be placed at the bottom of the page and numbered consecutively.
- **Quranic Verses:** Quranic verses should be written according to the Madinah Mushaf script in size 10, in plain black font, followed by the name of the Surah and the verse number in parentheses.
- **Tables, Figures, and Images:** Tables, figures, and images in the research should be arranged sequentially.
- **Mathematical Equations:** A uniform format should be used for mathematical equations within the research content.
